## Transportation within Toronto

There are various on-line documents that describe how to get around in Toronto. Here are some of the most relevant for CCM5 (and of course there is overlap between these)

- Payment by tap&go credit/debit card is available virtually everywhere (locals use a "Presto Card" that provides discounts for young/old/frequent users) but every Presto machine should take tap&go too.

  The Downtown Map at this link is particularly useful. Note that thick green and yellow lines are underground subway lines, red lines are streetcars and buses.
- Note that one can walk from Union Station (endpoint of Union Pearson Express train) to the Chestnut Residence/Hotel in under twenty minutes (map below) or take TTC subway to St Patrick Station and walk two blocks.
